We will cruise the spectacular waters of Willie Creek, providing unique insights into the modern cultured pearling industry, from the seeding of an oyster to the harvesting and grading of a pearl.. right through to the stunning showroom display. During this cruise of the spectacular azure waters of Willie Creek will see oyster panels suspended in their natural environment, view huge barramundi and other sea creatures in the aquaculture display. You may choose to enjoy lunch {own expense} at Willie Creek Grill.

Back to “Seashells” then dinner in your accommodations or a place of your choice. (own expense)

DAY 4. Sunday 24th May

A visit to Broome's **Courthouse Markets Commencing at 8 am** is the order of the day this morning. Pearl and jewellery stands, handmade candles, lamps and leather belts, hand blown glass, crystals, and so much more including local fresh produce and renowned mango smoothies are just a few of the delights we will encounter while strolling these stalls. Plenty of luncheon choices here, (own expense) to be enjoyed on the lawns or in the shady tropical gardens. Return to our art projects for the afternoon, or just relax and chill out in your villa. For something different, we will join the **Sunset camel safari** on Cable Beach. This is an optional activity, You will have the opportunity to tick "yes" or "no" on the information sheet provided to you upon booking. Cost is \$90 p.p. (own expense) and is one hour duration. We may then enjoy dinner at one of the Cable Beach Dining Options (own expense). A return to our rooms and welcome rest. DAY 5. Monday 25th May

A most exciting day awaits us today, as we join the **Horizontal Falls Tour**. This is a full day tour which will transport us to Beagle Bay and the famous **Pearlshell Church**, followed by a tea/ coffee break. We will stop at **Kooljarman for breakfast** and a walk along the pristine white sandy beach. A short distance away, we join the One Arm Point community and the Aquaculture Hatchery. Then it is **all aboard the 13 seat Cessna aircraft** for a scenic flight over the thousand islands of the **Buccaneer Archipelago**. You will experience a landing on Cockatoo Island and enjoy a barramundi lunch. Board our fast boat "Jetstream" for an exhilarating ride through the **Horizontal Waterfalls**. You may choose to swim in the shark/crook free cage. Fly direct back to Broome with spectacular aerial views of Cable Beach and Broome township. Plenty of opportunities for aerial photographs.

DAY 7. Wednesday 27th May

Windjana Gorge Tour

This full day tour travels east from Broome into the fascinating part of outback Australia, known as the Kimberley region. We head over the *Willare Bridge*, crossing the mighty *Fitzroy River*, for our morning tea break, then head to one of the Kimberley’s most famous landmarks, the *Boab Prison Tree*, once used to house convicts. Whilst here view *Myalls Bore*. Heading through the *Kimberley Cattle country* we continue along the famous *Gibb River Road* arriving at *Windjana Gorge*, for a scrumptious picnic lunch. Regarded as a classic world geological feature, the gorge is a renowned **freshwater crocodile spotting site**. Keep an eye out for wildlife hiding in the *Lennard River*, which runs through *Windjana Gorge*. The gorge’s limestone walls rise more than 100 metres and it is home to fossils of shells and sea creatures. Afterwards, head to *Tunnel Creek, a 750-metre long flooded cavern*. On this great adventure walk, wade through knee to thigh high water and hear the story of *Jandamarra*. The tunnel features many beautiful formations including stalactites and stalagmites and is also home to a variety of bats, olive pythons and freshwater crocodiles. Enjoy a swim at the end of the tunnel in a waterhole before heading back for afternoon tea and onwards back to *Broome* with a stop en-route for dinner (at your own expense). The approximate time of arrival is at 10:00pm. A drop-off to your hotel is included.

DAY 8. Thursday 28th May

This morning , breakfast at your leisure, before proceeding with our art project at 8.30—12.30 After lunch, relax and enjoy a free afternoon. Take time to attend to “chores” , take a *stroll through Chinatown*, {this area is a historic reminder of the early pioneers including Broome’s multicultural society as it is today,} take a nap, or simply chill out. Dinner tonight, at your pleasure and at own expense.

DAY 9. Friday 29th May

After breakfast, we will enjoy the efforts of those who participated in our art project, all should experience a sense of achievement today as we view and enjoy our completed artworks. Time for some great fellowship, more than a few laughs, and a chance to do that one last thing on your Broome bucket list, or simply relax, and enjoy a restful afternoon before dinner (own expense)

DAY 10. Saturday 30th May

A glorious surprise is in store today as we enjoy our *Mystery Activity*. Very little travel involved , but a wonderful, and delightful, somewhat unexpected but most enjoyable treat is in store.
